

2020 - 2021 Curling Season

Covid-19 Special Assessment Fee

Teams will be required to pay a one time \$100 special Covid Assessment Fee to offset costs incurred to meet our obligations regarding disinfecting and sanitizing

Game Play

Bell will ring after 90 minutes - teams to complete end in play

In the event of a tie - skips rocks will decide game - one sweeper will be permitted

Maximum ice time is 1 hour 50 minutes to provide time for ice crew to prepare for next draw

Covid-19 Waiver

Prior to the start of the season, all curlers and guests will be required to sign a Covid-19 waiver form relieving the Club of any liability should a curler or guest contract the virus.

Waiver forms will be provided by the Club

Safe Return to Play

- If you feel sick - **STAY HOME**, especially if you have a **FEVER**
- Arrive no more than 20 minutes prior to draw time, bring your gear and take it home after.
- Locker rooms will be open for changing only, lockers will be taped off
- Sanitizing stations will be situated in strategic locations in the Club
- Disinfecting solution and paper towel will be provided for curlers to wipe their rock handles
- Each curler is responsible for cleaning their own rock before & after the game
- **DO NOT TOUCH** other players rocks, foot wedges are allowed

**Curling Protocols**

- No hand shakes prior to or after game, no coin toss, teams can use online tool www.justflipacoin.com
- Only one sweeper can be utilized at a time, no relaying permitted
- The Skip on the delivering team has control of the house and is **not allowed** to sweep
- The Skip of the non-delivering team **must remain in the hack area** until all stones come to rest
- Odd numbered sheets start play at far end of rink
- Follow 2 meter social distancing guideline
- "Stand here" decals for non-sweeping players will be affixed to the ice surface

Miscellaneous

- The canteen **WILL NOT** be operating this season, **NO FOOD** coupons will be charged
- Charleswood School students **WILL NOT** be allowed entry during school hours
- The Club is trying to arrange for a snack menu delivery option from a local restaurant
- Lounge will close at 11:30 p.m. to allow staff time to clean and disinfect - last call will be at 11:00 p.m.
- Tables and chairs in lounge to be arranged to follow social distancing protocols - please **DO NOT MOVE** tables or chairs
- Guidelines are based on existing Government regulations and are subject to change
