Rules of Play

Rules

The Curling Canada Rules of Curling for General Play shall apply except as otherwise stated below.

Free Guard Zone

The five (5) stone Free Guard Zone rule applies. For clarity, a stone in the Free Guard Zone cannot be removed from play by the first FIVE stones of an end. The sixth and subsequent stones delivered can remove a stone in the Free Guard Zone.

Game Duration

All games will be a maximum of eight (8) ends, subject to the bell which will ring at one hour forty-five minutes (1:45) after the scheduled draw start time. When the bell rings, you can finish the end in progress and play one more.

- An end shall be considered complete and the next end considered in progress when the last stone of the end has reached the first tee line (delivering end).

Ties

Ties will be recorded as such. No extra ends are played or skips stones thrown.

Substitutes (Spares)

Substitutes (Spares) cannot skip or throw the last stones for a team. Otherwise they may play any position on the team.

Equipment

Delivery sticks are acceptable.
