

Head Ice Technician

The curling club is celebrating its 80th year and is in the process of looking for a Head Ice Maker.

The club has a successful and storied past producing champions at different levels of curling including Jeff Stoughton.

About the Role:

Charleswood Curling Club is seeking a Head Ice Technician to lead the preparation, maintenance, and improvement of curling ice surfaces throughout the season. Reporting to the Club Manager and/or Board of Directors, the successful candidate will be responsible for delivering safe, consistent, and high-quality ice conditions for league play, bonspiels, championships, competitions, and member use.

The Head Ice Technician will oversee all aspects of ice operations, including seasonal ice installation and removal, equipment maintenance, environmental monitoring, and supervision of Assistant Ice Technicians and volunteers.

This position may require evening, early morning, weekend, and holiday work based on ice maintenance schedules and club events.

Position Term:

This is a full-time, seasonal role from September to April.

Job Duties:

- Lead daily ice maintenance, including pebbling, scraping, clipping, cleaning, and ice condition assessments.
- Monitor and maintain ice quality, consistency, and playing conditions throughout the season.
- Plan and lead installation and removal of curling ice at the beginning and end of each season.
- Supervise, train, and support Assistant Ice Technicians and volunteers involved in ice maintenance.
- Operate, maintain, and coordinate servicing of ice-making and ice-maintenance equipment.
- Maintain curling stones (handle tightening, storage practices; coordinate conditioning/blueprinting as required).
- Monitor refrigeration, temperature, humidity, and environmental systems to optimize ice conditions.
- Assist with maintenance and upkeep of the ice plant, ice area, and related facility infrastructure.
- Develop and implement ice maintenance schedules for leagues, bonspiels, championships, and special events.
- Maintain records related to ice conditions, equipment maintenance, and operational requirements.
- Ensure compliance with all club policies, workplace safety procedures, and applicable regulations.
- Provide recommendations regarding equipment, supplies, and ice-related capital improvements.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.

Qualifications & Experience:

- Curling Canada Ice Technician certification or equivalent experience; Curling Canada Head Ice Technician certification is considered an asset.
- Demonstrated experience in curling ice-making and ice maintenance.
- Experience supervising staff, contractors, volunteers, or teams is considered an asset.
- Strong understanding of refrigeration systems, environmental controls, and ice maintenance equipment.
- Ability to troubleshoot operational and ice-related issues effectively.
- Strong attention to detail and commitment to providing consistent, high-quality playing conditions.
- Ability to perform physically demanding work, including lifting, bending, standing, and working in cold environments.
- Ability to work independently and manage multiple priorities.
- Strong communication, organizational, and leadership skills.
- Flexible availability, including evenings and weekends.
